Our goal is to grant \$1 million by 2021 in support of the Forest Preserves by building partnerships with Cook County's generous donor community. ## CAMPING

Mujeres Latinas en Accion, Proyecto Juventud teen youth program participated in its first program-wide overnight camping trip at Camp Sullivan in Oak Forest this summer. 49 teens and their mentors experienced the joys (and hardships) of camping, many for their first time. 78% of the teens had never been camping before.

"The program offered a new kind of experience that many teens were excited to participate in. Disconnected from any



technology...teens gained hands-on experience setting up their own tents, preparing their own meals, hiking, playing community building and outdoor recreational activities, stargazing, and a night campfire," says Maritza Rocha, Director of Youth Programs.

With support from the Foundation, the group's leaders participated in the Forest Preserves' Camping Leadership Immersion Course (CLIC), which provides group leaders with an overnight training to learn the in's and out's of camping -- and of guiding a youth group through its own camping experience.

This year the Foundation granted \$100,000 to the Forest Preserves of Cook County's first year of public camping opportunities at its newly created or redesigned sites across the County. The Foundation directed its support to make the joys of camping accessible to those who have never tried it before by providing funding for its 'Gear Library' rental, CLIC skills training, family camping sponsorships, and guided campground activities. Mujeres Latinas en Accion received a Foundation grant to support its participation in these programs.

#### **CONSERVATION CORPS**

This year, as part of its focus on expanding the Conservation Corps, The Forest Preserve Foundation supported the Student Conservation Association's 'Chicago Conservation Leadership Corps' Program with a \$70,000 grant. This program runs in partnership with the Forest Preserves of Cook County and Friends of the Forest Preserves. The goal is to accomplish habitat restoration goals while providing teens with employment experience, science education, and a self-esteem enriching summer. "This experience has changed my life in a way, by helping me figure out what I want to do with my life," said Nathan Taylor, who will now double major in Illustration and Wildlife biology.

The overall program supported

61 interns and 12 crew leaders this summer. Their accomplishments included removing almost 5 acres of invasive plants, improving 5 miles of trails and maintaining the gardens located at the preserves' nature centers. The exposure to hard work, opportunities for jobs and careers in conservation, special certifications such as chainsaw handling, and the deep bonds formed among crew members impacts the teens even more.

"You get to become one with nature in this job. I always liked it when the sun hit the leaves. Now I know what type of leaf it is," says Tamia, a 15 year old crew member.

### **MEMORIAL GIVING PROGRAM**

The Foundation offers residents the opportunity to honor a special person or occasion by planting a tree or installing a bench in their honor in the Forest Preserves. While creating a special place for families and friends to reflect and honor the lives of individuals, these donations enhance the preserves for everyone. A tree-planting ceremony is held in celebration of Arbor Day for friends and family of all tree donors.

This past year, dedicated benches and/or trees were placed in Busse Woods, Wampum Lake, and Deer Grove.

## **2015 EVENTS**

Foundation events bring like-minded individuals and community leaders together for a great cause and fabulous time.



#### **CONSERVATION CUP**

The Fourth Annual Conservation Cup was held on September 17 at the George W. Dunne National Golf Course in Oak Forest. Over 150 guests enjoyed a beautiful day of golf and helped raise \$168,000 in support of the Foundation's mission and programs. The Forest Preserve District of Cook County Board of Commissioners passed a resolution congratulating the Conservation Cup Host Committee, major donors and the winners of the Cup.



## YOUNG PROFESSIONALS ASSOCIATION

The Young Professionals Association hosted two fundraising and networking events this year, with \$7,500 in proceeds being granted to support the Conservation Corps program. Their spring social was held at Moe's Canting and featured Ernie Wong, founding Principal and President of site design group, ltd and former Conservation Corps participant. The group's Oktoberfest in the Woods event was held at Thatcher Woods, in conjunction with the Forest Preserves' 100 Years, 100 Events celebration. Guests met Conservation Corps crew members for a

first-hand account of the impact the program has on the participants and on the ecology of the preserves.


## **ARBOR DAY**
